## PATIO DOOR DESIGN

The KASTRUP ENERGY outward opening wood/alu patio door has a casement height of only 74mm. You get more light into your living room and you don't interrupt the facade appearance when combining patio doors with windows. Wood/alu patio doors that open inwards have a casement height of 90mm. Additionally, you can choose different threshold solutions for your patio door.



42mm pinewood threshold with aluminium step protection is standard for patio doors that open outwards and is not possible for patio doors that open inwards.



25mm aluminium threshold is standard for patio doors that open inwards and is also possible for patio doors that open outwards.



15mm low composite/aluminium threshold is an alternative for all types of patio doors.



43mm hardwood threshold in oak or mahogany is an alternative for all types of patio doors.


